James Mangels, Director of Student Services & Personnel presented a power point which included the Nutrition & Physical Activity Report Card. A summary of the data from the assessment of the physical activity environment was presented. (A copy of the report is on file in the Central Office.) Mr. Mangels also presented the District Wellness Committee Recommendations.

Mr. Mangels commended Ms. Dickerson for her exemplary management of food services and to three schools for reaching Bronze status, in which they will receive \$1,500.00 each. The Middle School is headed toward Bronze status and will receive \$500.00. He also reported breakfast participation has increased dramatically.

Ms. Sumner applauded Ms. Dickerson for her diligence in finding alternatives for students with allergies while continuing to follow mandated guidelines.
